We will not have a formal meeting, but based on the concern at our November meeting about the financial loss on the 2018 Cooler, I am proposing a breakeven budget for the 2019 Cooler on the last page of this newsletter. Note the following changes from the 2018 Cooler:

- Truck registration fee to be the same as the 2017 Cooler \$25/\$50, but without lunch (was \$10/\$20 in 2018)
- Dinner ticket cost to be \$30, the same as the 2017 Cooler (was \$25 in 2018)
- Eliminate one portable toilet (keep one flush "Ladies", one unisex ADA and one wash station)
- Only raffle will be a 50/50 at dinner
- Auction of donated items from chapter members at dinner (as entertainment).

Guest Policy Entering the Spice Hunter Building

All visitors must enter and exit food handling areas through the proper staff entrance points, sign the visitors' log upon entering the building and sign out at the end of their visit.

- A. Hands shall be washed by all personnel, including staff, contractors and visitors:
 - After each visit to a toilet
 - After using a handkerchief
 - After smoking, eating or drinking or any other activity that could possibly contaminate Spice Hunter products
 - After handling wash down hoses, dropped product or contaminated material
- B. Use of Hand wipes:
 - Hand wipes shall be used upon entering food handling or processing areas
- C. Visitors exhibiting visible signs of illness shall be prevented from entering areas in which food is handled or processed.
- D. No food or beverage allowed into the production or warehouse area.
- E. No tobacco products allowed into the production or warehouse areas.
- F. A green colored hairnet must be worn at all times in the production or warehouse areas. Safety glasses will be provided as required by the Spice Hunter Escort.
- G. A "snood" (or beardnet) must cover beards and mustaches. Respirators may be used in place of beardnets for mustaches only as long as the mustache is completely covered.
- H. Clothing
 - Shoes must have closed toes; no sandals allowed.
 - No tank tops or sleeveless shirts or blouses.
- I. All visitors shall be required to remove jewelry and any other loose objects. This includes watches, earrings, wedding rings, pendants & necklaces.
- J. Visitors on tours should be warned not to touch any machinery or product within the production or warehouse areas.
- K. No photography or recording is permitted

MINUTES OF THE CENTRAL COAST CHAPTER, ATHS

Chapman Estate, Pismo Beach, CA, November 17, 2018

We assembled at 11:00 for a limited tour of the estate grounds (limited somewhat by the improvements necessary to satisfy Americans with Disabilities Act access requirements).

The meeting began at 11:55 with 19 members and guests present. The recent death of member, Ron Tremper was noted with regret. Minutes of the August 18 meeting approved as published, but subsequent information revealed that the actual amount spent on flyers was \$577 rather than the \$1650 mis-stated in those minutes.

Glenn reported on our somewhat diminished checking account balance. With that in view, no action was taken on a Nipomo High School scholarship or further donation to the North West Truck Museum.

The high school has been reserved for the July 20, 2019 "Cooler". There was consensus to schedule the same caterer. There was discussion of the components of the 2018 cooler loss. Jim's survey made clear that the advertising expense didn't pay off. With no viable alternative in sight it was MSP to continue at Nipomo High School.

We drifted off in various directions for lunch about 12:50.
